### **ONLINE SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES LEAVE TIME FOR WORK AND FUN**

*Students across Ohio benefit from flexible school schedule*

**COLUMBUS, OH (May 25, 2006)** – The Virtual Community School of Ohio (VCS Ohio) offers high school students the flexibility to take summer school courses and still participate in activities such as sports and summer employment. Courses are offered online and are taught by certified, and highly-qualified, teachers.
