ONLINE SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES LEAVE TIME FOR WORK AND FUN

Flexible, convenient courses are open to all Ohio high school students

COLUMBUS, OHIO (May 5, 2010) – Virtual Community School of Ohio (VCS Ohio) offers high school students the flexibility to take summer school courses and still participate in recreational activities or hold a summer job. Online classes allow students to set their own schedule and work at their own pace from their own computer. Courses are open to students from all districts in Ohio.

For the first time, VCS will offer two summer sessions for added convenience. Subjects offered during both sessions include Algebra I, Algebra II, Art I, Business Math, Chemistry, Computer Skills, Creative Writing, Earth Science, Geometry, Government, Health, Introduction to Algebra, Language Arts I, II, III and IV, Life Science, Physical Education, Physical Science, Spanish I, U.S. History and World History. All courses are taught by certified teachers.

The cost is \$249 per course for non-VCS students and \$149 per course for current VCS students. First session begins June 14 and runs through July 9, 2010 and second session begins July 19 and runs through August 13, 2010. An online orientation session will be offered before each session.
