ONLINE SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES LEAVE TIME FOR WORK AND FUN

Flexible, convenient courses are open to all Ohio high school students

COLUMBUS, OH (April 9, 2008) – The Virtual Community School of Ohio (VCS Ohio) offers high school students the flexibility to take summer school courses and still participate in recreational activities or hold a summer job. Online classes allow students to set their own schedule and work at their own pace. These courses are open to students from all districts in Ohio.

Subjects offered this summer include Art, Computer Skills, Health, Physical Education, Language Arts I, II, III and IV, U.S. Government, U.S. History, World History, Business Math, Algebra I, Geometry, Introduction to Algebra, Spanish I, Life Science, Earth Science and Physical Science. All courses are taught by certified teachers.

The cost is \$200 per full-credit course and \$150 per half-credit course. Full-time VCS Ohio students pay a reduced rate and may be eligible for scholarships.
