SUPPLEMENTARY EDUCATION SERVICES:

Required posting per 200.39 (c) of 34 CFR Part 200.

VCS Ohio receives special funding for tutoring services through the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001*, for those families that qualify for free and reduced lunch. A form is included in the enrollment packet that must be completed and returned with the packet. Families are notified upon qualification for the program and then must complete the appropriate paperwork and return it to the Title Office on Refugee Rd. Since the number of slots are limited, families should return paperwork within 30 days of enrollment. Qualifying families are determined by income. Should a family feel they are qualified and have not received notification, please contact Sherry Kuenhle or Shawna Hamilton at the VCS office using the contact information below.

There are specific providers of the tutoring services that must meet standards and guidelines developed by the Ohio Department of Education. These providers are listed on the ODE website by county. A list of sample providers with the link is provided to families in the paperwork sent to those who qualify for the services. Sherry Kuenhle is the VCS contact person for SES services. She can provide assistance in completing paperwork, if asked, in selecting a provider, in facilitating the tutoring services, and in evaluating the effectiveness of tutoring in increasing student achievement.
